- Perform conceptual estimating on mechanical, electrical and plumbing portions of projects
- Produce quantitative surveys and accurate pricing for a project from its early inception through an acceptable working budget, GMP, or Lump Sum Price
- Obtain and present unit pricing data
- Develop working relationships with local mechanical/plumbing/fire protection/electrical/technology/LV System (MEP) sub-contractors in order to build and maintain a list of qualified bidders for all projects
- Responsible for outlining clarifications and qualifications within an estimate
- Provide back up for estimates to be used during analysis and review * Secure and contact sources for cost estimates for all specialty items
- Possess and apply knowledge of unit prices and the material/labor component
- Establish and maintain relationships with subcontractors and suppliers to ensure competitive pricing
